Student Member	A person who is engaged in formal postgraduate studies with a research component in transport and logistics (note 1)	Nil
Associate Member	A graduate (SLQF L5 or higher) who has obtained post graduate qualifications in transport and logistics at SLQF L10 or higher	Nil
	A person who has obtained academic or professional qualifications in transport and logistics (note 2, and 3)	Having at least ten years of industry experience in transport & logistics and considered after making a presentation demonstrating professional leadership, if so desired by the Board or demonstrate contribution on research outputs considered after making a presentation demonstrating professional leadership, if so desired by the Board
Regular Member	A graduate (SLQF 5 or higher) who has obtained recognized post graduate qualifications in transport and logistics at SLQF L10 or higher	Having at least three years of professional leadership in the practice of transport and logistics and is judged to have achieved professional leadership within the transport & logistics industry (note 4)
Fellow		Having at least fifteen years of experience in T&L having excelled as a Regular Member for at least six years and having functioned as an active member including committee member and office bearer for at least three years and is judged to have achieved professional esteem within the transport & logistics sector (note 5)
Life Member		After at least twenty years of being a Regular Member or a Fellow Member and having functioned as an active member including being a committee member and office bearer for at least three years, retired and as may be judged by the Board to be considered worthy of the distinction of being a life member of the Society
Honorary Member	A degree or full professional qualification (at SLQF L5 or higher) in transport or logistics or in a relevant field	A person who being not a member of the Society is deemed by the Board to be likely to promote the objectives of the Society and is invited by the Board to be an honorary member having so assessed after a well-received public address to the members.

10) Notes:

- Transport & Logistics will be interpreted as referring to any or more of the areas of aviation, public transport, land transport, freight transport, maritime transport, warehousing and supply chain management. Support areas of Information and Communication Technology, Economics, Engineering, Physical Sciences, Management, Mathematics, may also be considered as applicable on a case by case basis.
- An academic qualification constitutes a three-year degree (SLQF L5 or higher) from a recognized university from a field within the areas of transport and logistics.
- A recognized professional qualification in transport & logistics obtained through an examined course of studies equivalent to a 3-year degree or SLQF L5 or above.
- The demonstration of professional leadership should be based on a (i) written report on leadership experiences and contributions, (ii) a presentation on a key knowledge area and (iii) viva voce interview conducted by a panel appointed for such examination.
- The demonstration of professional esteem should be based on a (i) written report on the professional achievements, (ii) two letters of reference from supervisors, (iii) a presentation followed by a discussion on a research finding or innovation implemented in practice and (iii) viva voce interview conducted by a panel appointed for such examination.
- For the first five years after this rule comes in to operation, the period of experience in each membership category may be waived off in consideration to equitable level of membership held in other recognized professional bodies if the path by which such membership was obtained satisfies the eligibility for Regular Membership of the Society as given above.
